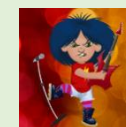

How can you continue to help at home?

- ❖ Reading- Please continue to read with your child for at least 10 minutes every day and record this in their planners. Children have their 'reading bingo' at the back of their planner. Please help to encourage them to read a range of genres (eg. fantasy, science fiction, information text, children's newspaper)
- ❖ Spellings- Spelling homework will be given every Friday. These will then be tested a week later.
- ❖ Times Tables- As a class, the main times tables that currently need focusing on are x7, x8, x9 and x12. Please continue to encourage your child to go on Times Table Rock Stars weekly at home to help support this.
- ❖ Maths - Year 5 children will continue to receive a weekly piece of maths homework (handed in on Thursday).
- ❖ Homework book- This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linked to the topic 'Marvellous Maps' covering a range of curricular areas. **There are four purple tasks that the children are required to complete by set dates. The other tasks are optional.**

Computing

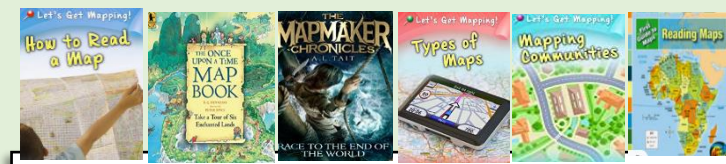
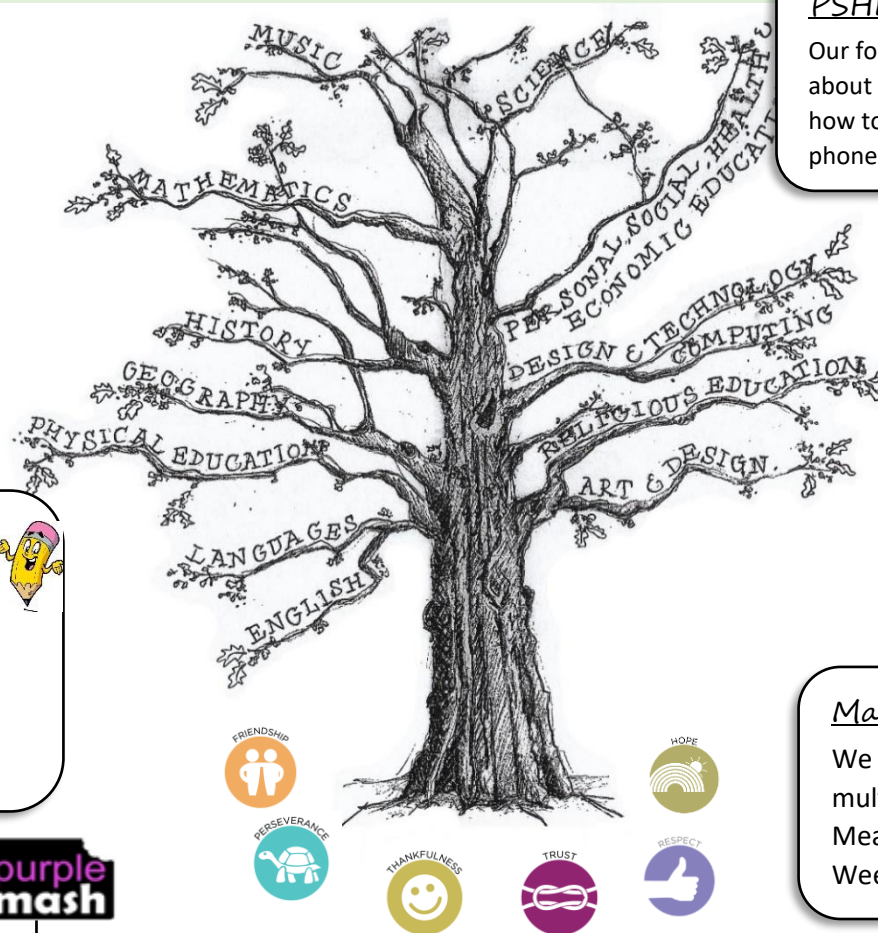
Our focus is multimedia and digital literacy.
