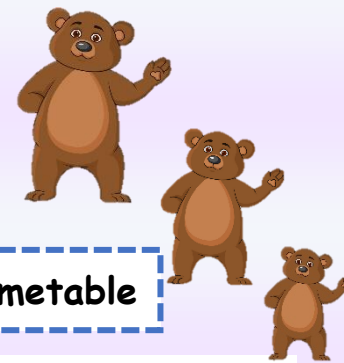


Class 2 Bears- Spring 1

Class 2's Sharing Assembly will take place during Spring 2.

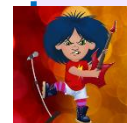

How can you help at home?

- ❖ **Reading-** Please continue to read with your child for at least 5 minutes every day and record this in their planners. Your child will bring home a **Bug Club Book** daily, which they can change in school when needed. Every Thursday, your child will bring home their **Little Wandle book**, which they will have looked at over 3 reads in school. Please share this book together at home and return this to school the following Monday. Your child will also have the chance to visit the **Library** once every 2 weeks.
- ❖ **Phonics-** A phonics task and weekly spellings will continue to be given each Friday linking to what we have been learning in class. Please continue to learn these at home.
- ❖ **Times Table Rockstars + Numbots-** Please continue to encourage your child to go on TTR and Numbots at home.
- ❖ **Homework book-** Your child will be provided with a "Homework Book". This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "Superheroes" covering a range of curricular areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and return it to school by the next Friday to be marked.

Letter- Writing a letter to Mr Buttery about the Superhero who invaded school.

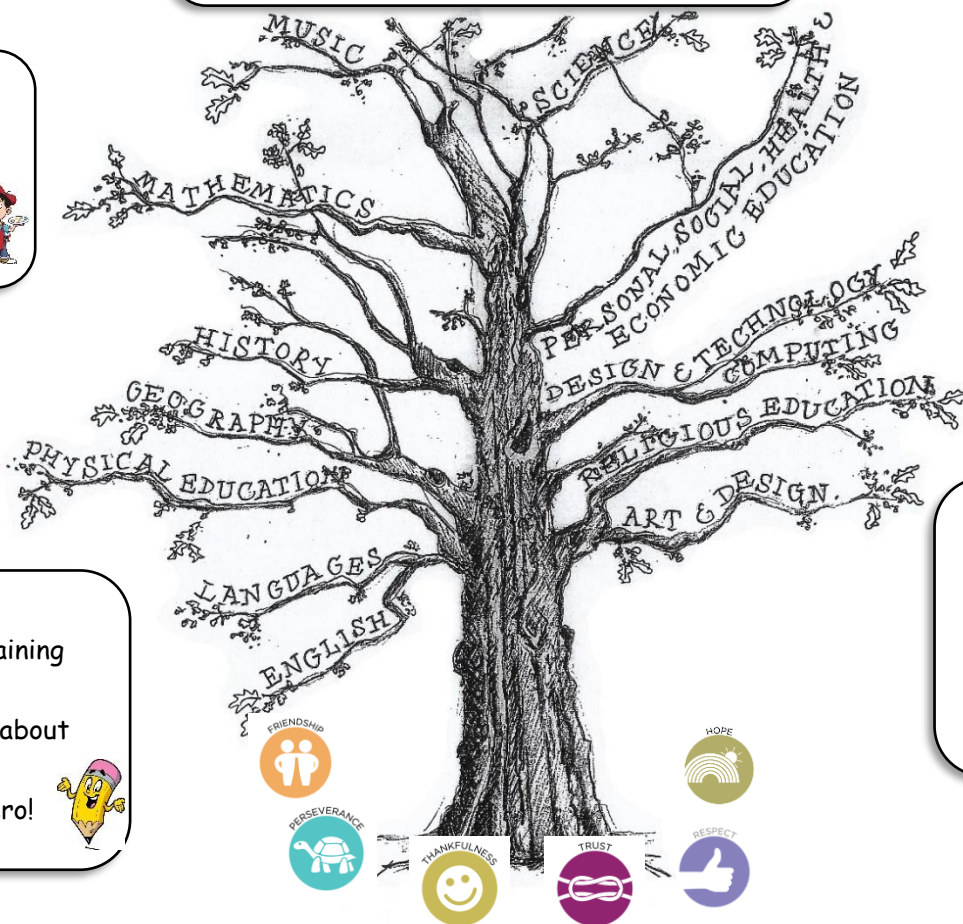
