How can you help at home?

- ❖ **Times Table Rock Stars-** Please continue to encourage your child to go on weekly at home.
- ❖ **Homework-** This term, your child will be provided with a "Homework Pack". Each week, there will be one, 'SAT-style' paper set as homework. Your child should try to complete this independently within the time stated. This can then be self-marked in an alternate colour and returned to school.
- ❖ **Alternative Arrangements -** Children in Class 5 may be allowed to walk home on an afternoon. Where this is the case, please ensure you let the school office know or pop a note in your child's planner.
