


*Indoor and outdoor labelled PE Kit on a Tuesday and a Wednesday.

How can you help at home?

- * Reading- Please continue to read with your child for at least 5 minutes every day and record this in their planners. Your child will bring home a Bug Club Book daily, which they can change in school when needed. Every Thursday, your child will bring home their Little Wandle book, which they will have looked at over 3 reads in school. Please share this book together at home and return this to school the following Monday. Your child will also have the chance to visit the Library once a week.
- Phonics A phonics task and weekly spellings will continue to be given each Friday linking to what we have been learning in class. Please continue to learn these at home. This half term we will be moving from 4 spellings to 6 spellings a week.
- <u>Times Table Rockstars + Numbots-</u> Please continue to encourage your child to go on TTR and Numbots at home.
- Homework book- Your child will be provided with a "Homework Book". This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "The Royals" covering a range of curricular areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and return it to school by the next Friday to be marked.
