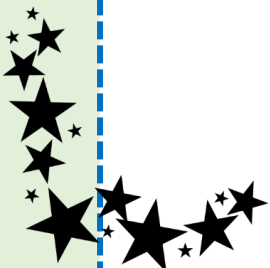

(The return of Spring)

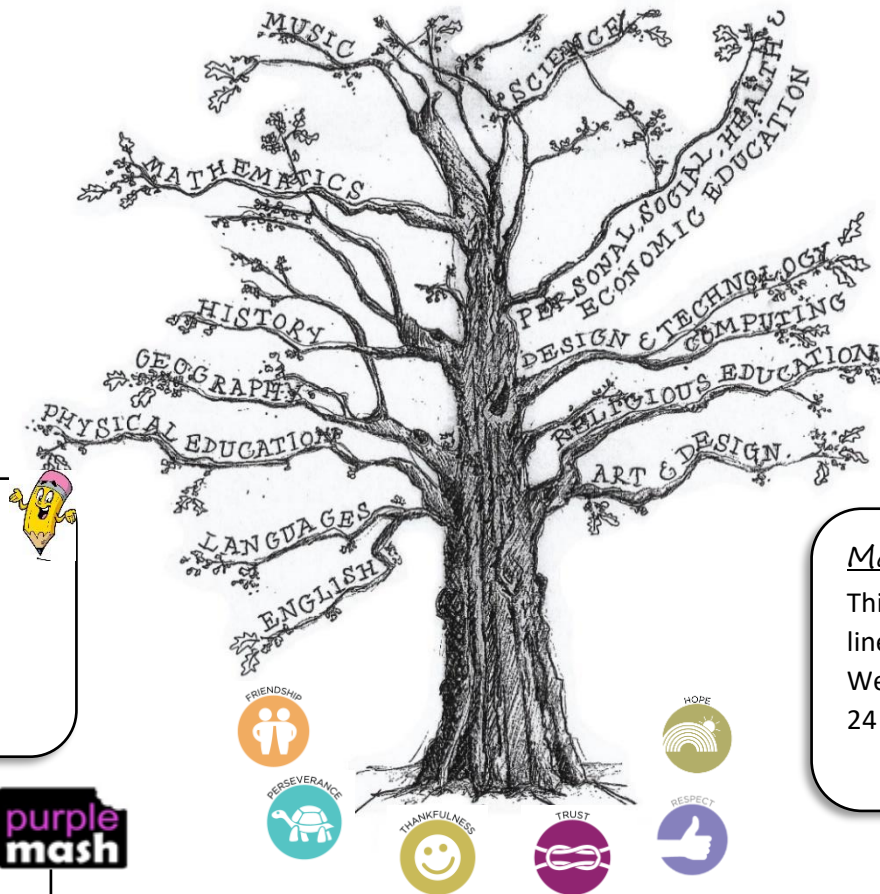
Our main focus will be to ask and answer questions about the weather, seasons and months.
