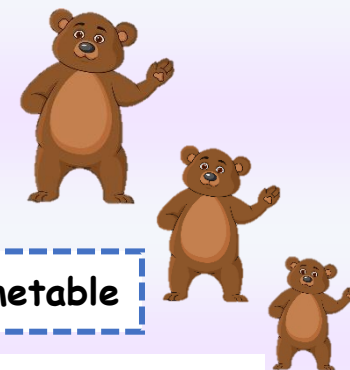


Welcome to Class 2 Bears!

How can you help at home?

- ❖ **Reading-** Please continue to read with your child for at least 5 minutes every day and record this in their planners. Your child will bring home a **Bug Club Book** daily, which they can change in school when needed. Every Thursday, your child will bring home their **Little Wandle book**, which they will have looked at over 3 reads in school. Please share this book together at home and return this to school the following Monday. Your child will also have the chance to visit the **Library** once every 2 weeks.
- ❖ **Phonics-** A phonics task will be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class. An additional sheet will also be provided, with a list of spellings linking to the phonics work to learn at home ready for a mini quiz in class. Phonics and spelling homework will be given every Friday and should be returned a week later.
- ❖ **Times Table Rockstars + Numbots-** Please continue to encourage your child to go on the following websites at home.
- ❖ **Homework book-** Your child will be provided with a "Homework Book". This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "It's all in a Picture" covering a range of curricular areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and return it to school by the next Friday to be marked.

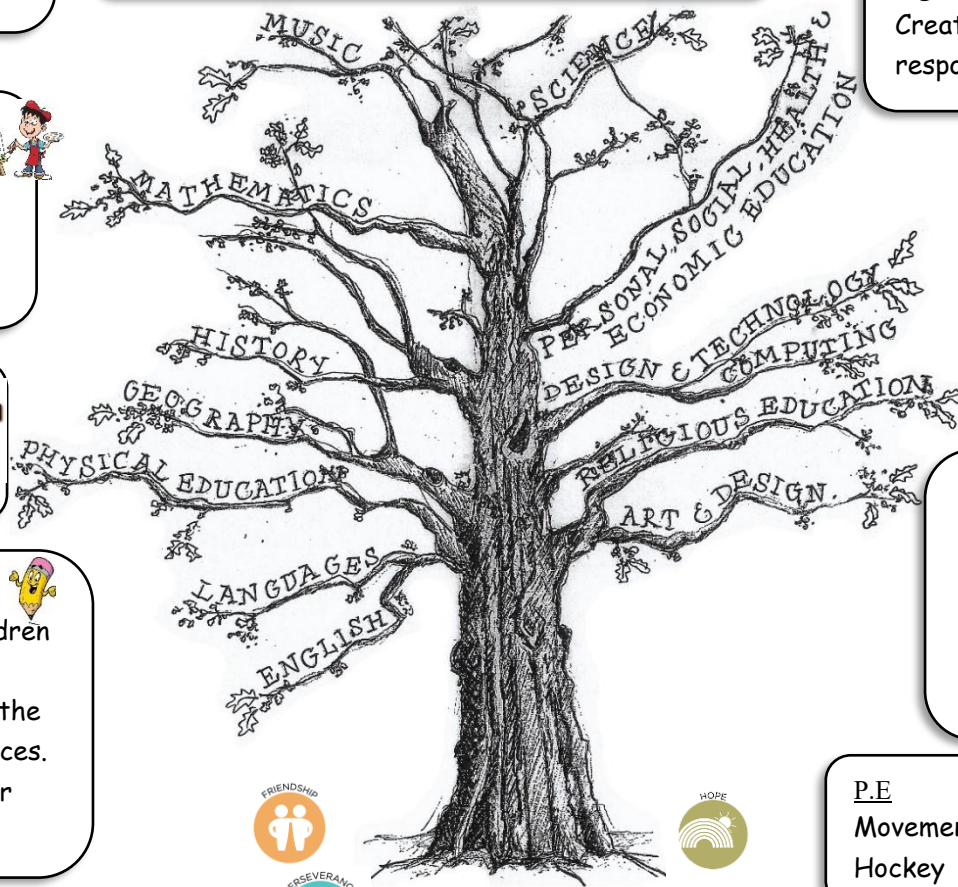
Maths
