## How can you help at home?



- Reading- We will continue to use our reading scheme, Little Wandle. Reading should be for no longer than 5 minutes, each evening and at this stage one or two pages. After reading with your child, please record this in your child's planner. This could just be a well done and the page number.
- <u>Phonics-</u> A phonics task will continue to be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class. The children will also continue to receive new flashcard sets and these will be placed within their wallet. Phonics homework and the flashcard pack will be given out each Friday and should be returned the following Thursday.
- Homework Task- This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to our topic theme "Bears" and coverage of a range of curricular areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and either share within the yellow homework book or via Tapestry, by the following Thursday.
