How can you help at home?



Reading- Please encourage your child to read their home school reading book. This should be for no longer than 5 minutes each evening. After reading please record this in your child's planner. This could just be a well done and the page your child will be on next.

Phonics and Spellings- A phonics task and spellings will be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class.

Homework and the flashcard pack will be given out each Friday and should be returned the following Thursday.

Homework book- Your child will continue to bring home a "Homework Book". This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "Superheroes" covering a range of curricular areas.
