3D work: Make a sarcophagus and a 3D pyramid.

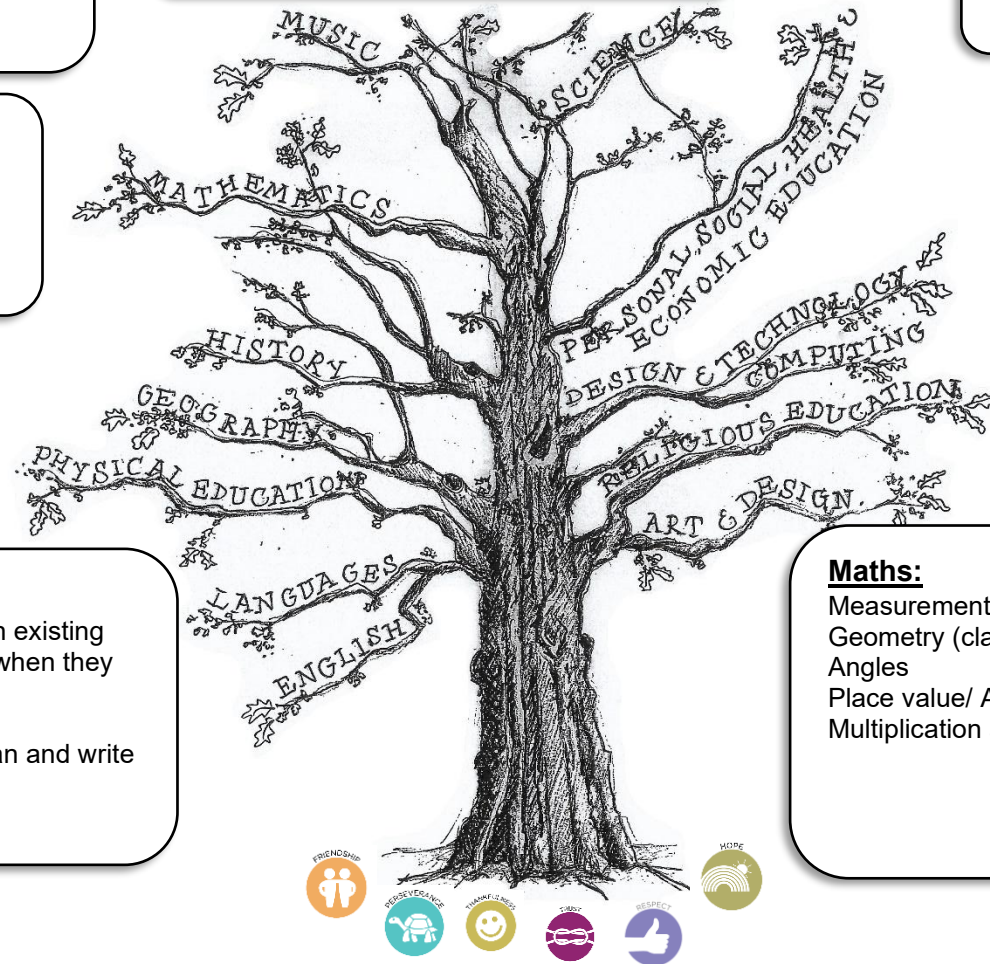
