\*A labelled water bottle




\*Indoor and outdoor labelled PE Kit for PE on a Monday and Friday. PE kits should come into school on a Monday and return home on a Friday to be washed.

- ❖ Last, but not least, please do come and chat with me if there is anything you would like to discuss this term. From Mrs Haffey and the Class 4 team!




