

CGP Practice Papers

Each week, you will receive a different paper based on the assessments in May. You should hand the answer or transcript pack to an adult straight away.

Ask an adult to give you the correct amount of time to complete the paper, and make sure you are working somewhere quiet. Once the allotted time has finished, review the paper together with an adult.

Any questions that you answered incorrectly, or did not have time to answer, should be revisited after a few days. For these questions, or for any questions where you received help, please use a different coloured pen.

Top Tips:

1. Practise the areas you answered incorrectly.

It may not sound like much fun, but it really will help.

2. Don't throw away easy marks.

Check over your answers carefully and make sure you read each question thoroughly.

3. Homework timetable:

1. You will receive a different paper as homework each **Thursday**.
2. Homework must be returned **already marked** by the following **Wednesday**.
