


Class 2 Bears- Spring 2



How can you help at home?

- ❖ **Reading-** Please continue to read with your child for at least 5 minutes every day and record this in their planners. Your child will bring home a **Bug Club Book** daily, which they can change in school when needed. Every Thursday, Year 1 children will bring home their **Little Wandle book**, which they will have looked at over 3 reads in school. Please share this book together at home and return this to school the following Monday. Your child will also have the chance to visit the **Library** every Thursday.
- ❖ **Phonics-** A phonics task and weekly spellings will continue to be given each Friday. **Year 1 spellings will increase this half term from 4 spellings to 6.**
- ❖ **Times Table Rockstars + Numbots-** Please continue to encourage your child to go on TTR and Numbots at home.
- ❖ **Homework book-** Your child will be provided with a "Homework Book". This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "**Squelch! Squelch Welly Boots!**" covering a range of curricular areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and return it to school by the next Friday to be marked.

Looking at the human and physical features of a farm in the UK and a farm in Kenya. Comparing the similarities and differences between the two.




Art & Design Technology:
