Religious Education:

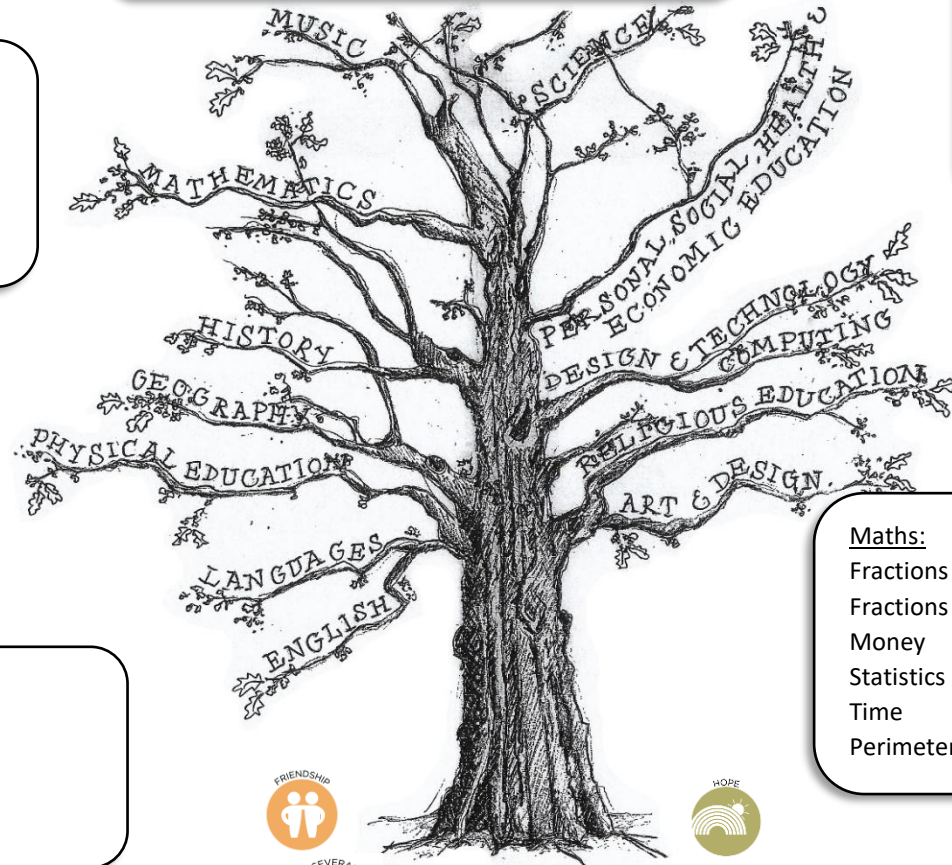
What kind of world did Jesus want?
