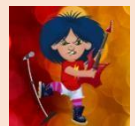


How can you help at home?

- ❖ **Reading-** Please continue to read with your child for at least 10 minutes every day and record this in their planners. Reading books can be selected from class bookshelves, the library or from home.
- ❖ **Spellings-** Spelling homework will be given every Friday and should be practised throughout the week. They will then be tested a week later.
- ❖ **Play-** Please encourage and support your child with any lines they need to learn.
- ❖ **Homework-** This final half term, there will be a grid of tasks covering a range of curricular areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and one maths' activity and return it to school by the next Wednesday to be marked.
- ❖ **Alternative Arrangements -** Children in Class 4 may be allowed to walk home on an afternoon. Where this is the case, please ensure you let the school office know or pop a note in your child's planner.

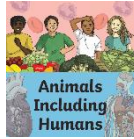

Science- Working Scientifically

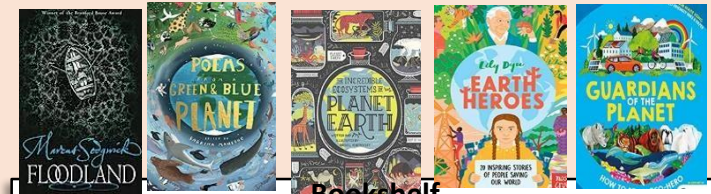
Animals including humans-

"What would Jesus do?"



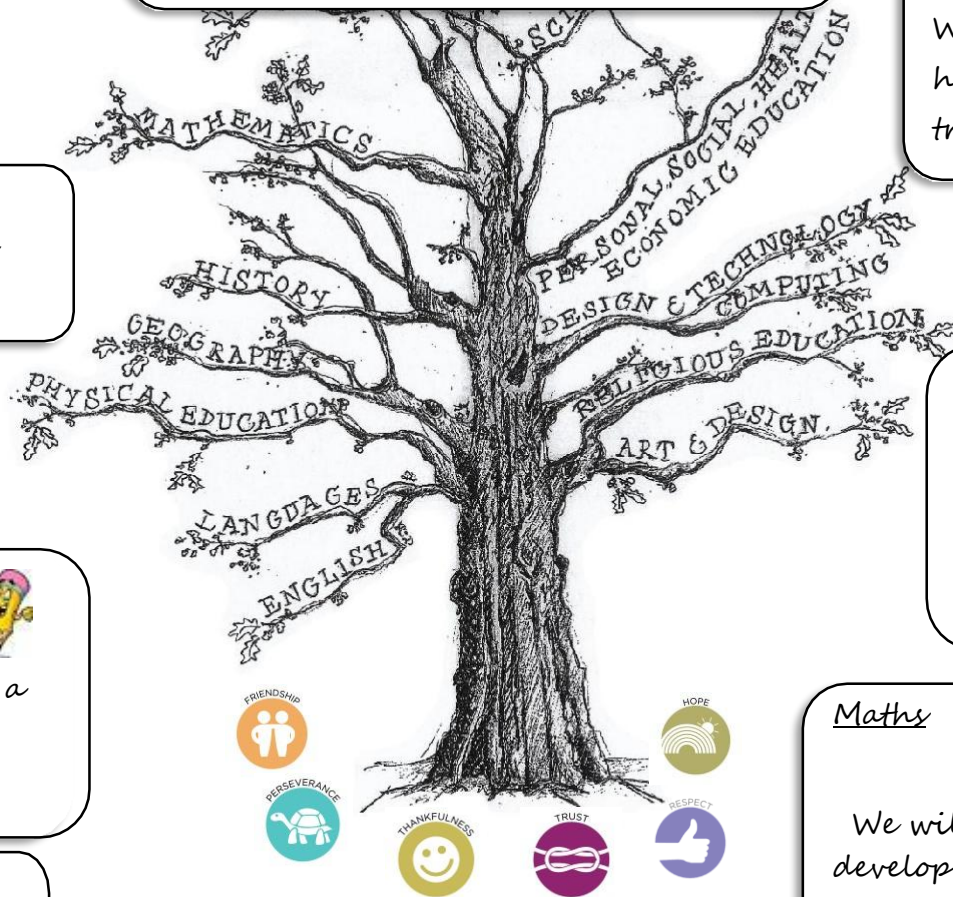
