How can you help at home?

Reading- Please encourage your child to enjoy holding a book the correct way, turning the pages and talking about what they see. Reading should be for no longer than 5 minutes, each evening and at this stage a few pages. After reading with your child, please record this in your child's planner. This could just be a well done and the page number. On the inner cover of each Little Wandle Book, you will also find some related activities to do with your child at home.

Phonics- A phonics task will be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class. You will also receive a pack to place your child's flashcards in as they receive a new set each week. Phonics homework and the flashcard pack will be given out every Friday and should be returned a week later.

Homework- Your child will be provided with a "Homework Grid". This half term, there will be tasks linking to our topic "Family and Marvelous Me" covering a range of curricular areas. Your child has the option to do a selection of tasks from the grid and share via Tapestry.

Numbots- Please encourage your child to go on Numbots and enjoy learning all about numbers. The children in EYFS will receive a password and this will be found in your child's planner.

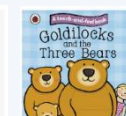

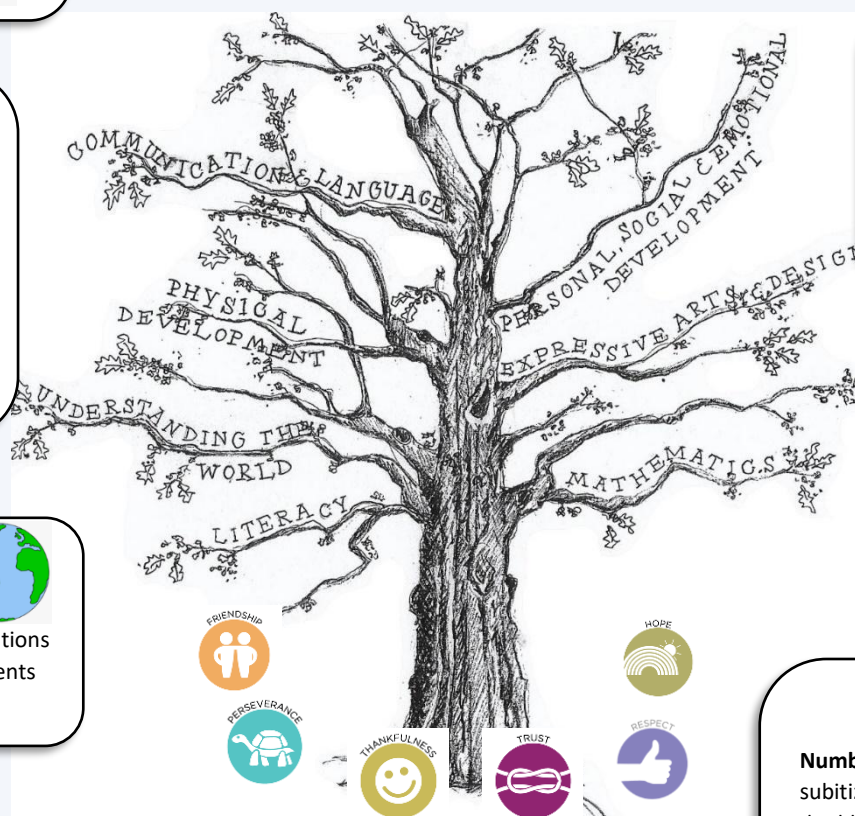
