EYFS:

100% of pupils achieved a good level of development in 2025 (Local Authority 71.4% 2025) and national 68.3% 2025) **+32%** when compared to national

Phonics screening:

95.7% of pupils passed the phonics test (Local Authority 80.6% and national 79.9% 2025) **+16%** when compared to national

Year 6:

Reading - average scaled score 107.4 in 2025 (national 105.6 2025) **+1.8** when compared to national

Reading - achieved standard 94.1% in 2025 (local 75.5% (2025) and national 75.1% 2025) **+19%** when compared to national

Writing - achieved standard 94.1% in 2025 (local 71.9% (2025) and national 72.3% 2025) **+21.8%** when compared to national

Maths - average scaled score 103.5 in 2025 (national 104.7 2025) **-1.2** when compared to national

Maths - achieved standard 70.6% in 2025 (local 74.2% (2025) and national 74.1% 2025) **-3.5%** when compared to national

Grammar, punctuation & spelling - average scaled score 104.2 in 2025 (national 105.4 2025) **-1.2%** when compared to national

Grammar, punctuation & spelling - achieved standard 70.6% in 2025 (local 72.9% 2025) and national 72.6% 2025) **-2%** when compared to national

Reading, writing and maths combined - achieved standard 70.6% in 2025 (local 62.6% 2025) and national 62.2% (2025) **+8.4%** when compared to national.
